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4.3.1 Public resources (lifelong learning)

Ajman University continued to promote lifelong learning in the year 2023, by providing public resources through its website to the broader community. AU offers free courses leading to certificates, free access to campus facilities and equipment, and free access to online resources. The AU Library provides books, articles, and databases to community members, school students (ages 15+), researchers, and government employees, with 64 of its 90 online databases available to the public. AU also offers free online courses on topics like IT tools, sustainability, climate action, and social skills, all accessible through its website. Additionally, AU supports open access to research articles through its repository. By providing these public resources, AU advances lifelong learning and knowledge sharing, aligning with its mission of fostering holistic access to education and promoting climate action.


A. Library Resources and Access

Ajman University's Library is a vital hub for learning, teaching, and research, providing resources and services that support University community as well as broader public whenever possible. With two branches in the Students Hub Building, the Males Library and Females Library offer an extensive collection of books, ebooks, journals, and databases, accessible via iPads, laptops, smartphones, library or computers. Through advanced




discovery tools like EDS, users can easily access and navigate digital content. The Library further supports users through a team of dedicated Reference librarians who assist with research needs and inquiries.

The Library collections include high-quality scholarly resources spanning all disciplines from top academic publishers, with 90 subscribed online databases available. Of these, 64 databases are open-access and freely accessible to the public. Users can benefit from additional services via the Library homepage, such as Ask-A-Librarian, Document Delivery, and mobile library app. Following ACRL Standards, AU Library ensures timely access to both print and digital resources, organizing its catalog by AACR2 and LCC. This commitment extends resources not only to students, faculty, staff, and researchers but, where possible, also to the external community.



Circulation Services:

Users must present a valid ID to the Circulation desk staff or when using a Self-Check workstation to check out a loan item.

- a) AU students, faculty, and staff: University ID
- b) AUD University and CUCA students, faculty, and staff must present valid IDs showing their home institution's ID number and barcode.



c) UAE Community Users: Library Membership ID.


The circulation desk is responsible for all transactions related to borrowing and returning books and periodicals, placing materials on reserve, recalling borrowed material, assessing fines, etc. Borrowing stops 30 minutes before closing time. Faculty members borrow 20 books per semester, postgraduate students borrow 20 books per semester, undergraduate students borrow 15 books per three weeks renewable for another three weeks, and



administrative staff borrow 05 books per 3 weeks renewable for another three weeks. Community users borrow 03 books per 3 weeks, renewable for another three weeks. Renewals can be done over the phone, online, or in person.

B. Educational Resources and Services for Community Users

AU library is open to all Ajman Emirate's community members, school students aged 15 and above, researchers from other universities, and all Ajman government employees.

Ajman University Library is pleased to invite all Ajman Emirate's community members, school students of age 15 and above, researchers from other universities, and all Ajman governmental employees to join AU Library membership under the following rules and terms.

Ajman University Library invites community members to conduct research on campus by participating in our Community Borrowers program.

Community Borrowers provide a AED 500 refundable deposit to establish a membership, which allows them to use most of the Library's resources for free, subject to availability.

When a user submits a completed form to cancel membership to Library staff and surrender the library card, they can refund their deposit.

Annual membership and Borrower Card fees are 50 Dirhams.

Community Borrowers are required to abide the guidelines to access the Internet and use the library's online databases inside the library following the AU Library Internet Access Policy. They can also borrow items from the library collection, excluding media and software.

Interested community members should complete the application for Community Borrower status and bring it with a photocopy of their EID and the 500 AED deposit to the university campus (Finance Office) to establish Community Borrower status.

Approved applicants will be issued a membership card to access the library and borrow materials on future visits.

It is preferred to pre-arrange a date and time to bring these items to ensure that the services of the cashier at the Finance Office will be available.

C. Free Access to Online Resources

Free-access resources are electronic research materials and resources made available to the general public free of charge: data and datasets, books and articles, including scholarly research articles. This is not the same thing as public domain works or items that have fallen out of copyright protection; open-access authors have chosen to share freely



so that anyone can use the works legally without permission or fees.



Sustainability Lifelong Learning

Ajman University (AU) emphasizes sustainability education as a cornerstone of its commitment to fostering an environmentally and socially responsible community. Through free, mandatory programs for students, faculty, and staff—and optional programs for the public—AU equips its community with essential skills and knowledge to support a sustainable future. Key initiatives include Environmental Sustainability Training, covering critical topics like climate change impacts, resource conservation, sustainable business practices, energy efficiency, and climate adaptation strategies, as well as Social Impact Training, which focuses on social responsibility, diversity and inclusion, ethical leadership, mental health, and quality education. AU provides an average of 25 hours of sustainability training annually for its employees and students, supplemented by relevant workshops, encouraging the AU community to drive positive change across environmental and social domains.

AU Climate Change Learning Program

Ajman University (AU) continued to offer comprehensive climate change training programs in the year 2023 that empower students, educators, professionals, and the external community to take meaningful action against climate change. These programs, in partnership with Coursera, the United Nations Climate Change Learning Partnership, and the UN Institute for Training and Research, cover a wide array of topics: from climate science and risk assessment to sustainable finance, human health impacts, and climate justice. Courses are tailored to different audiences—students preparing for climate-focused careers, educators gaining resources to teach climate concepts, professionals integrating climate into their fields, and citizens advocating for local action. Foundational courses, like "Climate Change: From Learning to Action," are mandatory for the AU community, while specialized topics such as carbon taxation and ecosystem-based adaptation are optional. AU also offers community-oriented programs, including junior school workshops and local awareness campaigns, supporting the integration of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) into personal and professional impact. Through these initiatives, AU is cultivating a generation of climate champions equipped with the knowledge and practical skills necessary to drive sustainable change.
