A. Local Collaborations

1. Ajman University Collaborates with Amina Hospital for Medical Check up

In the year 2024, the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Ajman University and Saudi German Hospital. Ajman University's College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences held a key meeting with the representatives of the Saudi German
