3.3.2 Health outreach programmes

Ajman University Hosts Health Outreach Program on Alzheimer's Disease and Neurobiology

In November 2024, as part of Ajman University's commitment to advancing mental health awareness and research, Ajman University recently hosted a significant health outreach program featuring Professor Karl Peter Giese, a distinguished researcher in neurobiology and mental health. During his three-day visit, Professor Giese, who is also the Co-Head of the Basic and Clinical Neuroscience Department at King's College London, shared his extensive research on Alzheimer's disease, focusing on the mechanisms of cognitive decline and the role of elevated protein synthesis in early stages of the disease. This health outreach program aimed to enhance understanding of neurological disorders, promoting health education within the academic community and beyond. The program particularly emphasized on health awareness, mental health education, and research collaboration. Professor Giese engaged with faculty, students, and research groups, discussing research methodologies, disease prevention, and potential joint research projects. The seminars on neurobiology and Alzheimer's disease provided valuable insights that contributed to global efforts to address mental health challenges, encouraged health literacy, and promoted collaborative health research—ultimately advancing the collective knowledge on cognitive disorders and neurodegenerative diseases.

Ajman University Empowers Healthcare Through Targeted Health Outreach Programmes

In January 2024, Ajman University demonstrated strong commitment to health outreach programmes through its participation in the 29th Dubai International Pharmaceutical & Technologies Conference & Exhibition (January 9–11, 2024). Final-year BPharm students actively engaged in presenting research projects on medicinal chemistry and pharmaceutics, fostering community engagement and knowledge dissemination beyond traditional academic settings. A joint effort between Ajman University and Gulf Medical University secured



second place in the "Best Quality Student Poster" category, reflecting the impact of collaborative research on improving health outcomes.

Importantly, Ajman University's faculty contributed to advancing community health outreach by developing and evaluating educational interventions aimed at hospital pharmacists. These included a pilot study assessing a pharmacovigilance educational module and a nationwide survey exploring pharmacists' knowledge and practices around medication reconciliation. Ajman University through such initiatives continues to play a vital role in enhancing healthcare professionals' capacity to deliver safer medication management and strengthen preventive health services, core components of effective health outreach programmes.

Ajman University has created a lasting social impact, demonstrating the importance of integrating skill development for inclusive community service to build a more healthy and informed society.

Ajman University Health Outreach Advanced Good Health and Well-Being with First Aid and CPR Awareness

As part of its ongoing health outreach initiatives, the Office of Sustainability at Ajman University organized a free First Aid and CPR Awareness Session. The free health outreach session aimed to promote health awareness, emergency preparedness, and community well-being by equipping participants with essential life-saving skills that can be applied in both campus and community settings. Led by a Nursing student with certified with first aid training, the session covered the basics of responding to burns, wounds, fractures, and choking emergencies. Detailed demonstrations on CPR techniques were provided, highlighting the correct steps to manage respiratory or cardiac arrest



situations until professional medical help arrives. Emphasis was placed on prompt, confident, and safe responses, enabling attendees to act effectively during emergencies.

The session was free and open to all members of the Ajman University community, reflecting the strong commitment of Ajman University to promote safety for the wellbeing of all through the inclusive health outreach. Participants engaged in interactive demonstrations, gaining hands-on experience in administering first aid, understanding emergency protocols, and recognizing the importance of immediate intervention.

Through this initiative, Ajman University not only raised awareness about first aid and CPR but also fostered a health-conscious, resilient, and empowered the community. By offering free access to vital health education, Ajman University contributed to the health and safety initiatives ensuring that members of the community are equipped to respond to emergencies safely and effectively. Ajman University Leads Health Outreach Programme with Breast Cancer Awareness Initiative
