

Ajman University Leverages Public Resources to Promote Lifelong Learning

In January 2024, Ajman University Library, in collaboration with Community Engagement, organized interactive storytelling sessions at Al Ahlia Charity School to promote inclusive access to education and cultivate a strong reading culture among young learners. Thirteen community volunteers contributed 39 hours to deliver engaging educational content and donated 300 books, enhancing literacy, fostering a love



for learning, and supporting equal learning opportunities. The initiative leveraged institutional resources and cross-sector collaboration to provide quality non-formal education, encourage lifelong learning habits, and strengthen community-based educational outreach.

Throughout the year 2024, Ajman University Library provides free access to public resources for all community users, including school students aged 15+, researchers from other universities, government employees, underserved community members, elderly and general community members. Through the Community Users Services Program, users can access print and digital collections, UAE heritage materials, 68 databases, and online resources and physical facilities. All services are free-of-charge and open to everyone, fostering lifelong learning, research engagement, and equitable access to knowledge. By



offering these resources to the wider community, Ajman University actively promotes inclusive lifelong learning and research for all members of the public.

Ajman University Enhances Digital Literacy and Skill Development through Student-Led Workshops

In January 2024, the Unity Developers Club at Ajman University, through the Office of Student Life, organized two comprehensive workshops aimed at introducing students to game development and programming. The Unity Interface Workshop provided participants with an immersive, hands-on experience in navigating the Unity game engine, while the 'C# for Beginners Workshop' offered foundational programming skills tailored specifically to game development. These activities engaged students in non-formal learning, fostering



creativity, critical thinking, problem-solving, digital literacy, and collaborative skills. By participating, students enhanced their technical competencies, developed transferable skills, and strengthened their capacity for lifelong learning, self-directed skill acquisition, and professional growth. The initiative demonstrates a commitment to expanding non-formal education opportunities and promoting meaningful learning experiences that prepare students for academic, professional, and societal engagement.
