Ajman University Enhances Access to Lifelong Learning through Public Educational Activities on Mangrove Conservation

Throughout the year 2024, Ajman University (AU), in collaboration with Al Zorah Golf Club and Al Zorah Development Private Company, launched the [Mangrove Planting and Golf Tour Initiative](#). AU's innovative education outreach activity, integrated sustainability, community learning, and experiential education was free-of-cost and open to all members of the public. Over thirteen (13) weeks, AU students, community school learners, and general public members engaged in free interactive workshops, field-based lectures, and guided learning sessions focused on mangrove ecology, biodiversity, and climate resilience. The initiative, led by Ajman University demonstrates how education can empower communities to address environmental and social challenges. Participants not only planted over 1,000 mangrove trees but also gained practical knowledge on conservation, ecosystem restoration, and sustainable living. The lifelong learning



initiative aligns with the UAE's goal to plant 100 million mangroves by 2030 and supports AU's mission to promote environmental literacy and lifelong learning.

By combining hands-on lifelong learning, public engagement, and scientific education, Ajman University continues to foster inclusive, high-impact and transformative community education for all.
