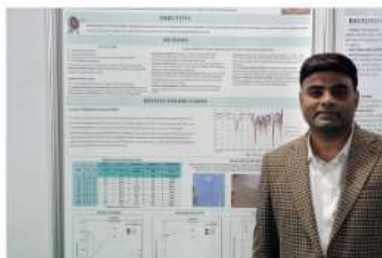

The session introduced attendees to the academic structure and
