Established in 1988 as the first private university in the GCC, Ajman University of Science and Technology (AUST) also was the first university in the UAE to admit expatriate students. AU continues to be a pioneer for inclusion, innovation, and social impact. AU is Licensed by the Ministry of Education in the United Arab Emirates. In 2016, the name of the university was changed to Ajman University (AU) to better reflect the comprehensive nature of programs offered by the university. AU offers 22 accredited undergraduate programs and 14 accredited graduate programs through its nine colleges. In 2020, Ajman University became one of the first six higher education institutions in the world to receive global accreditation from the Quality Assurance Agency (QAA), UK's independent body and a global leader in quality assurance for higher education.

It should be noted that the 17 SDGs are all linked among each other and are expected to be attained within 2030. 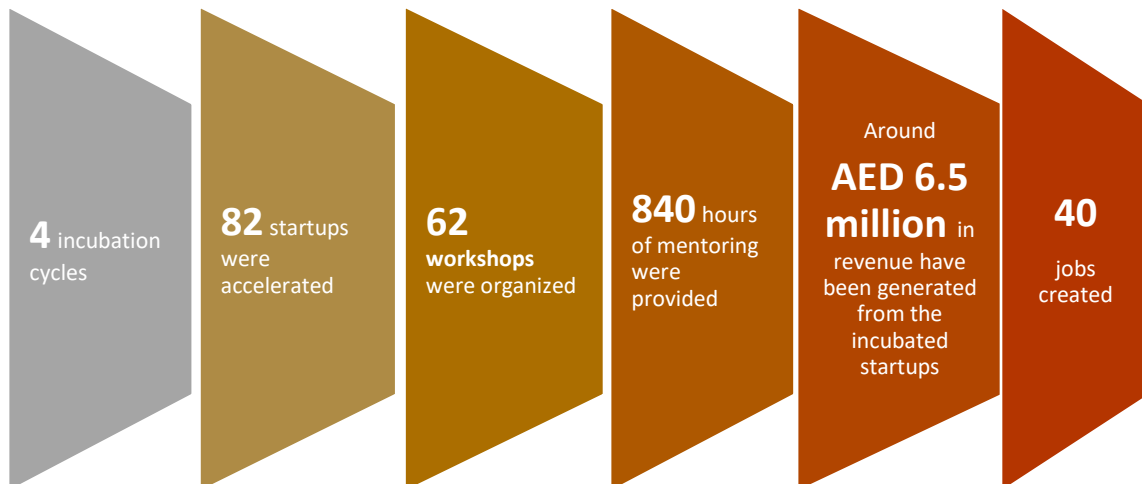

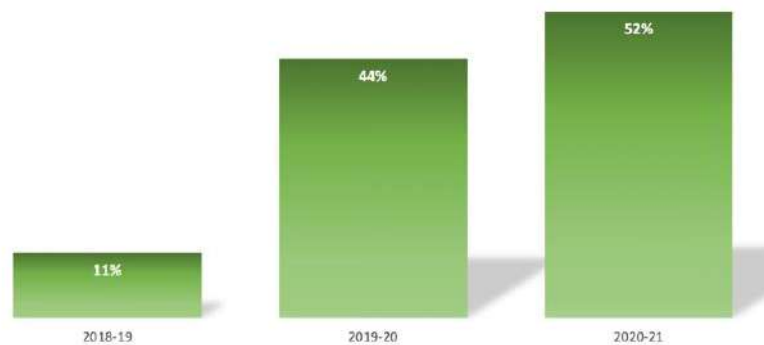

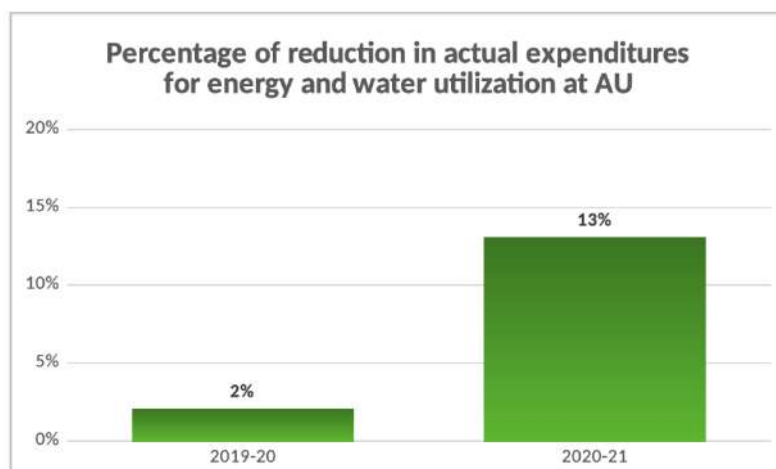

9- CPR Workshop

World Heart Day was celebrated by providing CPR workshop to the staff of the Canadian Nursery at Ajman. The 23 employees benefitted from this workshop and were given basic training by Dr. Alaa Al Amri, which is very important in case of emergency for every life. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is an emergency procedure that combines chest compressions often with artificial ventilation in an effort to manually preserve intact brain function until further measures are taken to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person who is in cardiac arrest. The staff was very thankful for this initiative done by Office of Community Engagement.



10- Awareness Campaign for Breast Cancer

24th October 2019 Damac Hills Park, Dubai

The whole month of October is a month of Breast cancer awareness, in which Unit of Community Service collaborated with Pink Caravan to have a "Pink Pride" walk of 5km and also have the awareness campaign by the fighters or survival of Breast Cancer who shared their experience. Diabetes from Periodontal perspective is a bit different. Diabetic patients are more likely to have periodontal diseases, which in turn can increase the blood sugar and diabetic complications. The guest speaker from Netherland name as Martin Verhulst very

beautifully explained to our dental students the process and the complications along with the precautions. There were 60 students who attended the seminar. The students actively participated the quiz at the end of the session to show that they were enthusiastically listening and won the game as well. The winners had prizes to encourage their involvement.



13- World Diabetes Day

16th November 2019 Penthouse, Ramada By Wyndham Beach Hotel, Ajman

World Diabetes Day is the primary global awareness campaign focusing on diabetes. Our aim is to raise awareness of diabetes, its prevention and complications and the care that people need. Although diabetes has no cure but, if people are aware then they can take steps to manage their diabetes and stay fit & healthy. We celebrated "International Round Table Conference - Type 1 Speaks" at Penthouse of Ramada by Wyndham Beach Hotel, Ajman. This 24 - hour walkathon included a silent walk as well only for the cancer patients. there were activities like storytelling session, poetry reading, comedy acts and DJ performances etc. The children enjoyed the bouncing castle, games, art, face - painting and crafts sessions.



15- CPR Workshop - LFGP School

Month of January 2020 Lycée français international georges Pompidou School, Student Hub, Ajman University

Unit of Community Service collaborated with Ms. Alaa Alamri to provide a CPR (Cardiopulmonary resuscitation) workshop to the children of Lycée Français International Georges Pompidou. LFIGP is a French international school with campuses in Dubai and Sharjah. There were 36 students from Sharjah branch of grade 5 who attended the workshop. They were accompanied by their teachers and very well-disciplined students of LFIGP School. It was the very first time in history providing CPR Workshop to this young age group, which is very important to aware them at early stage. Ms. Alaa also experienced and enjoyed the interesting question & answer session with the students who were more responsive and enthusiastic to learn more. They practiced on the mannequins and giving them an idea was the most important thing though they can't really help any individual at this age. Unit of Community service aims to raise awareness among all the gender and age group level. Lifesaving awareness sessions are very important and should be encouraged more in our community. It was another successful awareness session that Unit of Community service conducted among children.
